Application of Acid

- The acid should be applied every evening.
- A very small amount of acid should be applied carefully to avoid contact with the normal skin surrounding the wart.
- Apply the acid with a toothpick and cover with duct tape.
- The wart tissue may be removed once a week. This will help the acid work more quickly.
- After removal of the wart tissue do not apply the acid for a 24-hour period.
- If you should run out of acid, please return the container, and a refill will be given to you at no charge.
- Warts are difficult to kill it may take 4-8 weeks, sometimes longer, to see results.
- Apply moleskin with a cut out hole over the wart if instructed to do so.
